Helen Howard NCC Officer met Chairman and Clerk re relocation of 30mph signs. She is hoping to apply for a number of villages' signs to be relocated on one Traffic Order thus saving legal costs. New posts and signs will still need to be provided along with repeater signs from near to the small gate into the Sports Field. Footpath from Hollow Way to Sports Field may be more difficult to achieve, as Highway standards are required.
