- 5) Open Meeting
 - a) The Chairman said that he wished to congratulate Martin Rowling from the neighbouring parish of Culworth on the opening of his Diamond Jubilee Clock on 9th June.
 - b) Dodds Manor Farm Concern expressed that yet again the planning application has been turned down due to inconsistency of planning department.
